

**NORTH SEWICKLEY TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
November 13, 2012 @ 6:30pm**

The North Sewickley Township Supervisors held the regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, November 13, 2012 at 6:30pm in the Township Municipal Building. The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. In attendance were Supervisors Phil Dent and Linda Brown, Secretary/Treasurer Cindy Anderegg, Engineer William Hummel and Police Sgt. J.Becze. Supervisor Norman Giancola and Solicitor Phillip Clark were absent. Also in attendance were approximately 11 guests and 1 reporter.

VISITORS

Ed Bailes – 1. informed the Supervisors that there is still a problem with speeding in his neighborhood 2. Stated that the Road Crew needs to clean the ditch at the end of Bradford Street

Chase McCarthy & Gary Schenck – spoke to Supervisors regarding the installation of a pipeline – gave the Board a few drawings for their review – Ms. Brown wanted to have a meeting with them, the Supervisors and the Solicitor to discuss their offer.

Mr. Hummel stated that the Felician Sisters wished to speak with the Board of Supervisors regarding this subject.

George Sewall – 1. Requested that the Township do snow removal during the winter in his Plan. Mr. Dent stated that the Township would need a waiver of liability – Mr. Sewall said he did not have a problem with that request. 2. With regard to his retention ponds and the new building permits he has applied for, but which are being held up, Mr. Sewall would like to be able to continue with his construction and work on the ponds – he needs legal approval for this action. It was noted that legal counsel and a discussion need to take place regarding both requests – no action taken at this time.

Don Fisher - would like an update since the Supervisors' Road Tour and also wants a decision to his request to have the Township do work to alleviate his problem with water drainage. Ms. Brown stated that they think they will close Wildwood Road and stop the project. Ms. Brown clarified that only the section of Wildwood Road that is normally closed during the winter may be considered for permanent closing. Mr. Dent stated that there are 2 situations going on. A discussion followed. If the road is closed, Mr. Fisher would have access to his property.

Paul Shaffer – he has a drainage problem on the upper end of Wildwood Road and now he has a problem with it possibly being closed. He was to have a call back from Mr. Giancola after the Road Tour, but has never received a call to date. Ms. Brown replied that she would speak to Wayne Young, Road Foreman and then call Mr. Shaffer back when she knew what was to be done. He asked if he needed a lawyer. Mr. Shaffer asked if he could have a copy of the notes from the Road Tour – Mr. Dent also would like to see the notes as he did not go along on the Road Tour. Ms. Brown said she would type them up for them.

Richard Christy, vice president of the ladies auxiliary of the vfd, asked the 3 supervisors to make up a basket to be auctioned off at the Fire Department's auction.

A new plan for Erosion & Sediment Control is needed.
