

REGULAR MEETING JUNE 10TH, 2014

The regular meeting of the North Sewickley Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, June 10th, at 7:00 P. M. at the North Sewickley Township Building, 893 Mercer Road, Beaver Falls. In attendance were Supervisors Philip Dent, Linda Brown, Emmett Santillo and Solicitor Ryan Long.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Phil Dent, followed by the salute to the flag.

ROLL CALL: Chairman recognized that all supervisors present

REGISTERED VISITORS- Keith Aiken, Ann Aiken, Tami Ray, and Brad Kirkham.

Keith Aiken- Country Club Dr. still having problems with a storm drain that the Sewer Authority disrupted flooding his property.

Tami Ray- Glendale Rd. Neighborhood watch will have a booth at the Providence Baptist Church Community Carnival July 19th. Requested Township to donate coupons for free snow cone. Questioned Sewer Plan time frame, asked about the 2010 resolution.

Brad Kirkland- Country Club Dr. stated that the antiskid on Country Club Dr. is still there and is covering the white line on road. Stated that the road repairs from the gas company were sinking.

Leonard Beagle- Bennetts Run Rd. Questioned dirt on resident's property- is it properly drained.

Michael Gallagher- Christopher Gist St. Same issue about Antiskid material- is it necessary. Questioned drainage on Bradford Street to Wises Grove.

Jim Oliver- Nottingham Dr. Asked who determines the safety factor for streetlights. Can residents petition for installation or removal?

Catherine Pflugh- Barrisville Rd. Asked if there is any work planned for Barrisville Rd. Afraid someone will get hurt. Very dangerous.

Resident- Brown Rd. Complained that work done on Country Club Dr. was poor. Questioned if they were finished with the job.

Dean Westerman- Glendale Rd. Asked about Clean Up day costs- is The Township covering the costs of the services provided.

Ms. Brown read Permit Officer's Report- Permits issued -3 Pool, 1 Deck, 1 Addition, and 1 Shed. Submitted by Bette Swick.

Mr. Santillo read Police Report/ACO Report- Criminal Activity- Part 1 Offences- 4, Part II Offences- 22. Total Police Service Activity- 76. Parking Violations- 9 and Ordinance Violations-5. Total Miles driven 4,887.3 fuel consumed 320.5 Animal Control Report- 3 incidents handled. Submitted by Chief Becze.

Ms. Brown read the Road Report- Patched potholes on Sunset Dr., Stuber Rd., Maxine Dr., Oakland Dr., Kindale St., Lower Davidson St., Grandview Rd., Fleetwood Rd., Barrisville Rd., and Bologne Valley Rd. Replaced a cross drain on Bologne Valley Rd., Started mowing Township roadsides. Made a new grate for a catch basin on Edgewood Hill. Cleaned Drains and worked on Township equipment. Used total of 232 gallons of diesel fuel. Submitted by Wayne Young.

William Hummel- Engineer Report- Prepared bid packet and advertising for road project. Discussed bond issue for unimproved section of Thompson Run Rd. and the possible Barrisville Rd. project.

Ryan Long – Solicitor Report- Requested the Supervisors to make motion to ratify the sale of the cold patch to Riverside School and a motion to advertise and for reimbursement by the Volunteer Fire Department for the Hazardous Abatement Material Ordinance to be considered for adoption at the July meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Santillo gave update that Boy Scouts reinforced the retaining wall at the Bradshaw Park playground.

School Zone Flashing Lights on hold until Mr. Hummel provides the site plan necessary to submit to PennDot.

Mr. Santillo made the motion to adopt Fire Insurance Escrow Ordinance-061014. Ms. Brown seconded. Chairman asked for questions/comments. All in favor.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Brown made the motion to approve advertising for the Hazardous Abatement Material Ordinance for consideration at the July meeting. Mr. Santillo seconded. Chairman asked for questions/comments. All in favor.

Mr. Santillo made the motion to adopt Resolution #061014-2 Sign Management Plan. Ms. Brown seconded. . Chairman asked for questions/comments. All in favor.

Ms. Brown made the motion to approve and ratify the sale of the cold patch to the Riverside School District. Mr. Santillo seconded. Chairman asked for questions-comments. All in favor.

Ms. Brown made the recommendation that the Supervisors meet with the Zoning Hearing Board. Ms. Brown to coordinate.

Mr. Santillo made a motion to approve the bills as submitted. Mr. Dent seconded. Chairman asked for questions/comments. All in favor.

Further Discussion called for. Mr. Long brought to the Supervisors attention that there is a cemetery on Chapel Drive not being maintained. Discussed Township responsibility and options.

At 7:50 P.M. Mr. Santillo made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Brown seconded the motion. All were in favor.
