Ms. Brown read the Road Report- Worked on Township equipment, used grader to cut ice buildup in multiple locations, replaced sign at Lexington Drive and Schnauzer Lane, resurfaced 8 (eight) speed limit signs, cut down dead tree on Stuber Rd., along with numerous miscellaneous projects. Discussion about 2015 Clean-Up Day was held. May 16<sup>th</sup> from 8 am to 12 pm was decided. Ms. Brown made the motion to keep the pass price at \$15 for 2 (two) trips the same and to accept electronics. Mr. Santillo seconded. Chairman asked for questions/comments. All in favor.

Spring Road Tour was discussed and decided to be held on April 15<sup>th</sup> at 9 am.

Mr. Santillo made the motion to approve the bills as presented of \$115,174.55. Mr. Axtell seconded. Chairman asked for questions/comments. All in favor.
